

Film Summary

Synopsis: *Activized* follows the stories of seven ordinary Americans who, for the first time in their lives, leave their comfort zones and become involved in gun violence prevention, voting rights and immigrants' rights. Interweaving their personal stories against the backdrop of the causes they fight for, we experience their motivations, successes and failures, their sacrifices, and victories. Above all, we celebrate these inspiring, courageous citizens for embracing one of the most basic of American traditions – dissent.

Engage & Connect

Before Watching Activized

Connect using these prompts before watching:

- What does it mean to be a citizen in a democracy?
- Who do you think of when you think of an 'activist?'

After Watching Activized

Prompts to use as guideposts for post-screening:

• Talk about one particular activist or story who stood out to you, or touched you, or to whom you could relate.

- Have you had the experience of speaking out about something you believe in? What was it like for you? What was it that inspired you to speak out?
- Discuss the role of activism in a healthy democracy. Think about historical examples of activists who contributed to social change. Who were they, and how did they do their work?
- The individuals in the film used many different skills and aspects of their personalities in their actions, from lawyering and speaking Spanish, to public speaking, music, dance, and art. What skills and talents do you have that you might contribute to a cause you believe in?
